#### **Responsorial Psalm:**

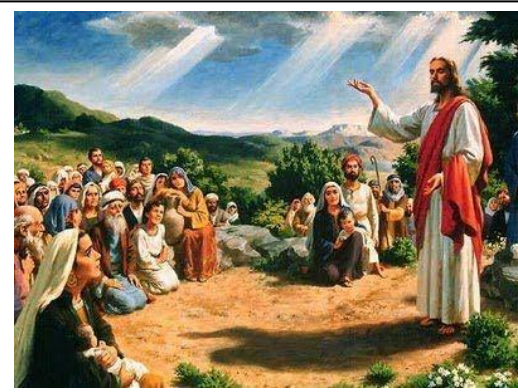
“Make a joyful noise to God, all the earth!”

## DISCIPLESHIP- A CALL TO LISTEN, BELIEVE, REMAIN AND DO

*Isaiah 66.10-14; Psalm 66.1-3a, 4-5, 6-7a, 16+20(R.1); Galatians 6.14-18; Luke 10.1-12, 17-20*

For St. Paul, Christian life means to be like Christ sharing the gifts with others and carrying the marks of Christ’s passion on our body (Gal.6.17). The two requirements for this are sharing the gifts we possess with others and carrying the cross of difficulties, challenges and sufferings we face every day in life. St. Paul proudly proclaimed that “I carry the marks of Jesus branded on my body” (Gal. 6. 17). He vividly mentioned the crosses he had to endure in 2 Cor. 11. 23-29: ‘...more imprisonments...countless floggings...near death moments...stoning, shipwreck...danger from bandits, danger in the wilderness and at sea, sleepless nights, hunger and daily pressure because of anxiety...’ This account of St. Paul shall inspire and motivate us to accomplish the missionary task all of us must fulfill as followers of Christ. Listen to Him, believe, remain with Him always and do good for others as He was doing in the ‘villages and towns.’

While Mathew and Mark tell us about the sending of the twelve, Luke recorded it as seventy and made a comment that the “harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few” (Lk.10.1-2). This second and expanded missionary group might have been a second sending called for by the shortage of time and the volume of work which Jesus could not do by himself. The demands of today are very complex, and the Church needs more committed and loyal “labourers”, to continue the works of the Lord and faithfully participate in the establishment of the Kingdom of God as envisaged, preached and worked by Jesus. We are reminded to continue the redemptive work already accomplished by Christ, the ‘twelve’, the ‘seventy’, the great holy men and women of the past.

Our discipleship today can be summed up in two phases: “Come and see” and “Go and tell.” Experience the Person of Jesus in our lives and share it with others. The total, self-emptying service shown by Christ shows us how to do the works of redemption today as his followers. We need a simple lifestyle, prepared for service and not to place too much attachment to material things: “no purse, no haversack, no sandals.” He rules out all marks of pride and arrogance (Lk.10.1-12). We participate in the mission of Jesus when we listen, believe and do His will. A great crowd of his disciples came to hear Him (Lk 6. 17). Those who believed and remained with Him were His disciples: “If you remain in my word, you will truly be my disciples” (Jn.8. 31). Those who do the will of God are my mother, brothers and sisters (Mk.3: 31-35).

A disciple is one of the twelve personal followers of Christ (Mt.10.1- 4). The disciple is also one of the seventy followers sent by Christ (Lk. 10.1). Anyone who listens to His Word, remains with Him, believes in Him and does His will is also a disciple of Jesus. We are his disciples, and we proclaim that Christ is the Lord, and we witness him through our life, and we are partakers of his mission of establishing the Kingdom of God – “eternal and universal kingdom, kingdom of truth and life, kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace”. We, in our own way, contribute towards the building up of God’s kingdom wherever we are here on earth.
